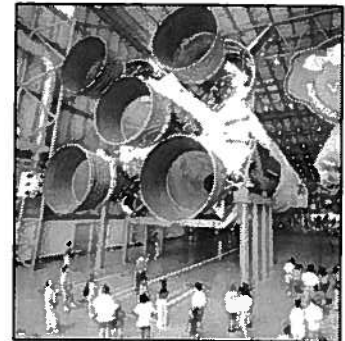

A must-see Visitor Complex experience, this tour takes guests on a tour of the Kennedy Space Center. The first stop on this go-at-your-own pace tour is the four-story LC-39 Observation Gantry, where guests enjoy a panoramic view of Kennedy Space Center and the Space Shuttle launch pads, as well as the rocket launch pads at Cape Canaveral Air Force Station. A short film and interactive displays demonstrate how the launch pads are constructed and how a Shuttle is launched.

Buses then drive by the monstrous Vehicle Assembly Building (VAB) where the Space Shuttle is stacked for launch, and where the Apollo/Saturn V rockets were once assembled, as well as the Orbiter Processing Facility (OPF) where the Orbiter is examined and maintained after each mission.

The second stop is the Apollo/Saturn V Center (ASVC), where dramatic multi-media shows and numerous hands-on displays provide visitors with an inspirational and exhilarating look into America's quest for the moon. Guests relive the historic launch of Apollo 8 at the Firing Room Theater, then marvel at a monstrous 363-foot Saturn V moon rocket, the most powerful rocket ever built, and one of only three Saturn V rockets in existence. Finally, the Lunar Theater provides a rare look at the harrowing final moments before man landed on the moon.



From the ASVC, guests have the option to continue to the International Space Station Center or return back to the Visitor Complex. The International Space Station Center. The International Space Station is the largest and most ambitious space program since the historic Apollo moon landings. Nations representing every continent are joining together to create the Station that will weigh almost one million pounds and cover nearly a football field when completed. The ISS Center provides an unmatched, up-close look inside the actual facility where NASA is processing ISS components. Highlights of this interactive tour also include replicas of a habitation unit; a laboratory module; and the Multi-Purpose Logistics Module.

In 1887 Winter Park was originally developed for wealthy Northerners as a summer retreat. You will be taken to the Park Avenue shopping district where the Southern charm that lured the elite society can still be seen. Picturesque shops, boutiques, cafes, brick-lined streets and the towering trees of Central Park make Park Avenue the place to be and be seen. Start your tour with a relaxing, 45-minute pontoon boat ride while gliding through canals and tree lined lakes. View beautiful homes nestled along beautiful lakes and observe nature. Following your boat tour, browse the exclusive boutiques and art galleries filled with one-of-a-kind treasures, as well as stores bearing the names of your favorite designers. This collection portrays his radical treatment of glass whereby several colors were combined and manipulated to create an unprecedented range of hues and three-dimensional effects that made him famous. The Charles Hosmer Morse Museum of American Art houses the world's most comprehensive collection of the works of Louis Comfort Tiffany (1848-1933) including Tiffany jewelry, pottery, paintings, art glass, leaded-glass windows, lamps, and the chapel interior he designed for the 1893 World's Columbian Exposition in Chicago. The Museum's holdings include a major collection of American art pottery and representative collections of late-nineteenth and early-twentieth century American paintings, graphics, and decorative arts.

Jeannette Genius McKean (1909-1989) founded the Museum in 1942 and named it for her industrialist grandfather. Its collections were built over a half-century by Mrs. McKean and her husband, Hugh F. McKean (1908-1995), the Museum's director until his death.

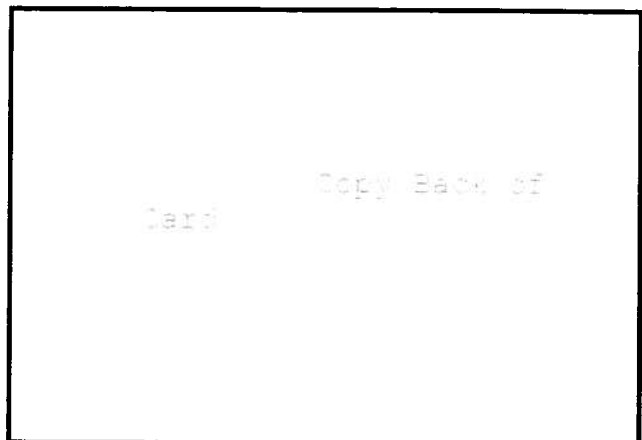
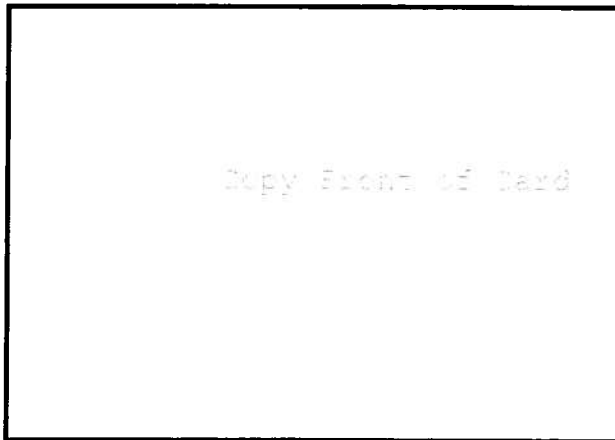
